1) PROGRAMME OFFERED:

BHMS	Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery
Duration	4 ½ years + 1 year CRR (Internship)

2) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- a) Candidates must have passed in 10+2 /H.Sc. (or) its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination mentioned above for General Category and 40% marks in respect of the candidates belonging to SC / ST / OBC Category. In respect of persons with disability (PWD), the minimum marks shall be 45% marks for General Category and 40% marks in case of SC / ST / OBC.
- b) In addition that, the candidates must have obtained the minimum marks at 50th Percentile in the NEET UG-2023 for General Category and 40th Percentile in respect of the candidates belonging to SC / ST / OBC Category. In respect of candidates with benchmark disability (PWD), the minimum marks shall be 45th Percentile for General Category and 40th Percentile in case of SC / ST / OBC Category.
- c) Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.

3) DETAILS OF FEES:

4) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- a) Candidates who have been allotted through centralized counseling by the **AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH**, Govt. of India, New Delhi for admission to **BHMS Degree Programme** in the Deemed to be University for the academic year 2023-24, are advised to report and complete the admission process strictly within the date and time specified in the **“Allotment Letter”** issued by the **AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH**.

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- b) The candidates should report along with **original certificates and Demand Draft** or UTR Number for **Electronic Fund Transfer through NEFT / RTGS** for the prescribed tuition fee and other fees as specified herein.
- c) i) Candidates without original certificates / documents shall **not** be allowed to take admission in the allotted Homoeopathy Medical College.
ii) Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute / College / University and come for admission with a certificate stating that “their original certificates are deposited with Institute / College / University” shall **not** be allowed to take admission in the allotted Homoeopathy Medical College.
- d) Every student shall pay the tuition fee and other fees, as prescribed by the University, within the due date notified.
- e) Part payment of tuition fee and other fee are not permitted.
- f) No extension of time either for payment of fees or submission of original certificates will be entertained under any circumstances.

- g) At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration / undertakings declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University including Anti-Ragging regulations of the UGC / NCH and observe the good conduct and behaviour and that they are bound by the University rules on payment of fees / refund of fees.

5) MODE OF PAYMENT OF FEE:

a) TUITION FEE & OTHER FEES:

It is mandatory that the candidates should bring the prescribed tuition fee and other fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “**Vinayaka Mission’s Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital**” payable at Salem or remitted through NEFT / RTGS as mentioned in the Fees Structure.

b) HOSTEL FEE & MESS FEE:

Separate hostels available for male and female, the candidates have to pay the prescribed Hostel fee & Mess fee in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “**KV STAR PROPERTY MANAGEMENT**” payable at Salem as mentioned in the Fee Structure.

6) IMPORTANT NOTE:

- a) Candidates are advised to check the website of the **AACCC** (AYUSH Admissions Central Counseling Committee) of Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, New Delhi **website:** www.aacc.gov.in and College website: www.vmhmc.edu.in from time to time.
- b) Allotment letter given by the AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH for admission is subject to fulfillment of all the eligibility criteria prescribed by the National Commission for

Homoeopathy and medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit, will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the **AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH**. If it is found at a later stage, that the candidate has given false information / forged certificates or concealed material information, his / her admission will be cancelled without any notice.

- c) Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fees, disciplinary rules and hostel rules and UGC / NCH Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging etc.
- d) All the disputes / arbitration arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions in this prospectus will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor, Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University) and Vice-Chancellor's decision shall be final and binding.

7) REFUND POLICY:

1	In case of re-allocation / Upgradation during the round 2 /3 of counseling.	No fee will be deducted.
2	In case of resigns after the first round of counseling.	Rs. 25,000/- will be deducted.
3	If any candidate resigns / withdraws after the second round of counseling.	No refund of Tuition fee & Other fees.
4	Penalty to be imposed if any candidate resigns / withdraws from the course resulting in rendering the seat vacant.	If any candidate discontinues from the course and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fees paid will be forfeited and the student has to remit the 'entire course fees' for the remaining years of the course period.
5	If any candidate resigns / withdraws after the last date of admission as prescribed by the AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH / NCH .	The entire Course fees for the remaining years of the course period has to be paid by the candidate.

NOTE:

If the qualifying examination is other than that conducted in India, candidate should Submit the following certificates / details.

- ii) 12th Grade Transcript
- iii) 12th Pass Certificate (in case of CBSE or ISCE) or High School Diploma Certificate
- iv) Accreditation details of School & Numerical conversion of Grades into marks

9) JURISDICTION:
