## 3) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MDS PROGRAMMES

- a) The candidates must possess BDS or an equivalent Degree recognized by the Dental Council of India/ Government of India, New Delhi.
- b) The candidate must have permanent registration of his / her name with any State Dental Council /DCI.

- c) Candidates should have qualified the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET- MDS 2017).
- d) Candidates of all Indian citizens belonging to any State / Union Territory of India including NRI are eligible.

**NOTE:** Mere appearance in NEET-MDS 2017 does not confer any right to the candidate for admission into **MDS Programme**. The selection and admission is subject to the fulfillment of all the admission criteria on eligibility, All India rank in NEET - MDS 2017 merit list, medical fitness and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Government of India, Dental Council of India, Government of Tamilnadu and Vinayaka Missions University from time to time.

#### **4) ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE**

Candidates who have passed qualifying examination other than Vinayaka Missions University should obtain Eligibility Certificate from Vinayaka Missions University, Salem.

#### **5) IMPORTANT NOTE**

- a) Candidates are advised to check the website for updates for both State Government and University website [www.vinayakamission.com](http://www.vinayakamission.com)
- b) All admissions are subject to fulfillment of all the eligibility conditions by the candidate. If it is found at a later stage, that the candidate has given false information / forged certificates or concealed material information, his/her admission will be cancelled without any notice.
- c) The University reserves the right to change the rules relating to examinations, refunds, etc.
- d) All disputes/ arbitration arising in the interpretation and implementation of the

provisions in this prospectus will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of Vinayaka Missions University and Vice-Chancellor's decision shall be final and binding.

## 6) MODE OF SELECTION FOR ADMISSION & PAYMET OF TUITION FEES

- a) Selection will be made on the basis of the All India Rank secured by the candidates in the NEET MDS -2017 through Common Counseling by the Govt. of Tamil Nadu on the dates notified by it.
- b) The option exercised by the candidates at the time of Common Counseling is final.
- c) On receipt of allotment letter after Common Counseling, the candidates should report to the Office of Vinayaka Missions University on or before the date mentioned in the said allotment letter, with documents in **original**
- d) At the time of admission, It is mandatory that the candidate should bring the prescribed tuition fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “ **Vinayaka Mission's Sankarachariyar Dental College**” payable at Salem (mentioned in the Fee Structure)
- e) Every student shall pay tuition fee and other fee, as prescribed by the University, within the due date notified. The fees are subject to revision as per rules of the University.
- f) Part payment or payment of tuition fee and other fee by installment is not permitted.
- g) No extension of time either for payment of fees or for submission of original certificates will be entertained under any circumstances.

## 7) VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- a) All admissions are subject to verification of the original certificates and documents of the candidates. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final regarding the eligibility of any applicant for the admission under the Vinayaka Missions University.

- b) If at any time, before or after admission, it is found that the candidate does not meet the eligibility requirement, the seat shall be denied to him / her. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that he / she meets all the eligibility requirements.

## **8) CHANGE OF NAME/DATE OF BIRTH**

The name of the candidate will be registered in the records of the University as given in the Degree /Mark Statement/ Provisional Certificate and the Date of Birth as per 10<sup>th</sup> / H.Sc /Transfer Certificate only. No request will be considered later in regard to change of Date of Birth or correction in the name of the candidate. The parents and candidates are requested to verify and confirm these entries in the relevant certificates

## **9) REFUND POLICY**

- a) If after admission made through First counseling, the candidate desires to withdraw from the course so admitted, he/she should do so by giving a written request duly signed by him/her and counter signed by parents both father and mother, sufficiently early or in any case at least two clear calendar working days before the scheduled date of the Second counseling as per time frame by the State Govt. In such cases of withdrawal, only 90% of the tuition fee will be refundable. However, the hostel rent paid, if any, will be refunded in full.
- b) However, for candidates admitted through subsequent counseling(s) the tuition and other fees will not be refunded, in case of withdrawal from course

## **10) DISCONTINUANCE FROM COURSE OF STUDY**

- a) Where any student applies for discontinuance, or without any application discontinues on his / her own, from the course to which he / she has been admitted, for any reason either after the cut-off date of final counselling fixed by the Government for admission

to the first year of the course concerned or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate from waiting list etc., such student shall have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the entire / remaining course period. Unless and until payment of all the prescribed fees for the entire / remaining course period is made to the University, such student shall not be entitled to any certificate including transfer certificate, mark sheet etc., to be issued by the University.

- b) All students and parents shall be required to furnish a declaration agreeing to the above said conditions at the time of admission.

## **11) PREVENTION OF RAGGING**

- a) 'Ragging' means indulging in any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational Institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do. In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution.
- b) In this context every student of the institution and his/her parents, or guardian is required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration / admission in prescribed format (which will be provided by the institution) which is mandatory for registration / admission.
- c) Anti ragging regulations of the University Grants Commission and Dental Council of India are forming part of the terms of admissions and are made available to all candidates and their parents for information and compliance. All institutions are obliged to strictly adhere to anti ragging regulations.
